While working as a teacher, he participated in establishment of ME-net and held “High School Admission Guidance For People Whose Mother Tongue Is Not Japanese” in 1995, the first event of its kind in Japan.



Having been taking part in local study classes and supporting youth from diverse backgrounds for 28 years, he is currently supporting 4 study classes (Miratobi-kyoushitsu, Aikawa-kyoushitsu, CEMLA kyoushitsu, and Saturday class at Kawasaki high school). He is also advisor for “education for student with multicultural background”, the program run by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Japan (MEXT).
